In Europe alone, the number of potential beneficiaries of eye tracking technology amounts to several hundreds of thousands but only a fraction of these people are actually using eye control in order to make their lives easier and more enjoyable. For many of them, eye control is potentially the quickest, least tiring and most reliable form of access to technology. The EU -funded COGAIN project aims to make sure that as many of their needs as possible can be met through eye control. The talk will include video illustrations of some of the work done with potential users so far.
