RAATE Conference and Exhibition

26th & 27th November, The Cutler's Hall, Sheffield.

RAATE is the only UK conference focused on the latest innovations in Assistive Technology and is organised by IPEM (The Institute of Physics Engineering and Medicine). The conference attracts delegates from across the UK who uses, works with, develops or conducts research on Assistive Technology (AT). This conference is a unique opportunity to meet professionals who work in AT, develop or conduct research or who have a particular interest in this area.

This year RAATE is collaborating with the £1.9 million pound Advanced Care Technologies (ACT) Programme. Supported and part funded by Objective 1 to interact with the regions businesses to exploit the rapid expansion of the assistive technology, rehabilitation products and service requirements to meet demand of an ageing population.

This exciting collaboration means a change of venue, to The Cutler's Hall in Sheffield, and the opportunity to bring together even more different aspects of the Assistive Technology world.
